- Up to 29 dwell days in the absence of signs and symptoms of infection, infiltration and extravasation.
- Do not use device for power injection.
- Dressing change needed every 7 days or as needed. Keep dressing dry and intact. If dressing becomes loose, soiled or wet, it must be changed.
- Do not take blood pressure in arm with Leaderflex.
- Do not start peripheral IVs below Leaderflex.
- Flush per organizational policy.
- Do not use for continuous vesicants or irritant infusions. Use for infusions that are ideal for peripheral devices.
